
New minimum wage as of January 1st, 2016

This past December 11th, 2015, the Representative Council of the National Minimum Wages Commission (CONASAMI in Spanish) agreed to a general increase in the minimum wage of 4.2%, which will apply throughout the Mexican Republic. Such resolution was published today in the Official Federal Gazette.

The minimum wage will come into effect as of January 1st, 2016 and it will be:

- Single Geographic Area MX\$73.04 Pesos.
